

Drop in Suspended PVC Ceiling Tile

PVC drop in ceiling tiles can be used in an existing grid system without the need to remove the existing tiles. It is best to retain the existing acoustical ceiling tile as it provides additional weight insulation, soundproof and increased fire rating. They can be used on any size ceiling and are easy to handle by DIY individuals.

In order to determine how many PVC drop in ceiling tiles you will need to calculate the area you intend to cover up or you can easily count the number of existing tiles and use this as a basis for your calculation. It is always best to have extra tiles in case of damage or some need to replace some tiles. As a rule, an overage of 5%-10% is recommended.

Please note the picture may not reflect current the accurate shade of the tiles as appearance can be impacted by the camera, the lighting, the internet, as well as the monitor. There is a difference in shade from batch to batch and we do not guarantee that the colors will match. We strongly recommend ordering the entire quantity with overages in one order.

If the lines of the grid system do not have the same color as the tile you intend to install, then you will need to paint it. This is to ensure that you have the right color balance.
